NOTIFICATION

No. 8/259/90-RR-II/ 10778 President of India is pleased to make the following amendments in the grant of Financial Assistance to the victims of Riots/Terrorists Rules 1985 published in the Punjab Government Gazette dated 21-11-1985 vide Punjab/Notification No. 13/330/3SW-85/9413 dated 18th Nov., 1985 and subsequent amendments made vide Notification No. 17/179/3SW-86/547 dated 16-1-1987 and 17/179/86-3SW/13949 dated 21.12.1988.

 - i) These Rules may be called subsistence allowance to widows of Riots/Terrorists violence (Amendment) Rules, 1990.
 - ii) The words "Department of Relief and Resettlement" be substituted for the words "Department of Social and Women Welfare and Welfare of Scheduled Castes and Backward Classes" where they occur in these rules.
 - iii) The Words " Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) be substitute for the words " District Social Welfare Officer" where they occur in these rules.
 - iv) The words "Director Relief and Resettlement" be substituted for the words "Director Social Welfare" where they occur in these rules.
 - v) These rules shall be applicable throughout the State of Punjab.

2. ELIGIBILITY Sub Rule (i) and (ii) of Rule 3

shall be substituted as under :-

- i) Sikh migrant orphans who have no earning member to help them and have no means of livelihood;
- ii) Sikh migrant destitutes who have no earning member to help them and have no means of livelihood;
- iii) Disabled Sikh migrants whose physical disability rendered them incapable of earning livelihood.
- iv) Sikh migrants/widows who lost their breadwinners during the period from 31.10.1984 to 7.11.1984 (both days inclusive). in the riots following the assassination of the Prime Minister Mrs. Indira Gandhi

- v) Widows who lost their bread-winners due to extremists/terrorists activities/action of security forces acting in aid of civil power;
- vi) Orphans, destitutes and 100% physically disabled persons, rendered as such, due to terrorists/extremists activities/action by Security forces acting in aid of civil power.
- vii) The dependent parent(s) of innocent civilians killed in terrorists violence/by Security forces acting in aid of Civil power.
- viii) Dependent parent(s) of the innocent civilian killed if he was unmarried, provided the son was the sole breadwinner for his parent(s).

Provided that the Subsistence allowance will stop as and when the beneficiary gets employed or an able bodied person becomes an earning member of the family.

3. ELIGIBILITY Part (a) of Rule 3 deleted.

- (b) That the applicant is not getting any kind of pension/family pension or any regular financial assistance from any other source.

Provided if any widow is already drawing financial assistance less than Rs.1,000/- per month from any other source, she is entitled for financial assistance under this scheme, provided the amount already sanctioned to her may be deducted before making the payment.

4. MAKING OF APPLICATION The Rule 4 will be amended as below :-

- i) The application form shall be made available without any cost in the offices of the Sub-Divisional Officers (Civil).
- ii) The application for subsistence allowance shall be obtained in form VR-I, from the widows/claimants by the Sub-Divisional Officer (Civil) at his own level, in which the applicant resides or has migrated.

5. VERIFICATION Rule 5 will be amended as below :-

- 1) The applications received by the Sub-Divisional Officer (C) shall be verified by him/or got verified from the Revenue Agency to ascertain whether the widow or the claimant has lost her/or his breadwinner, record this certificate on the application. The Subsistence allowance shall be sanctioned and disbursed by the Sub-Divisional Officer (C) within a period of 10 days. The payment may be made through the Bank Draft only.

- ii) In case of the disabled persons, it shall be obligatory to obtain considered medical opinion from any medical officer, who shall clearly indicate the nature of disability and whether the same is permanent or of temporary nature. Subsistence allowance shall be admissible in case of 100% permanent physical disability.

6. Rate of Subsistence allowance.

Subject to the provisions of Rules 7 and 10 the Subsistence allowance shall be payable to each applicant @ Rs.1000/- Per month except the dependent parent(s) as mentioned in Sub-Rule (Vii) of Rule 3, where the Subsistence allowance shall be Rs.100/- Per Month. The amount shall be remitted through Bank Draft to the claimants. Subsistence allowance under this scheme is payable for the life time, with effect from 1.5.1990.

8. POWER TO SANCTION FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE.

The Sub-Divisional Officer (c) concerned shall be the sanctioning authority under this scheme. He/She shall pass orders in each case on the basis of the certificate referred to in the column of Verification-Vide rule 5 above.

The expenditure involved is debit to the head "2235-Social Security & Welfare-60-Other Social Security and Welfare Programme-110-Other Insurance Scheme (09) Relief to persons affected by riots"-01-subsidy allowance to victims of November 1984 riots and 02-subsidy allowance to victims of terrorist violence in Punjab.
