Notification

The 22nd January, 1992

No.8/259/90-RR-2/504. The President of India is pleased to make the following amendment in the Subsistence Allowance to widows of Riots/Terrorists violence Rules, 1990 published in the Punjab Government Gazette dated 10-5-1990 vide Punjab Government Notification No.8/259/90-RR-2/10776 dated 10-5-1990 and subsequent amendments made vide Notification No.8/259/90-RR-2/6211 dated 26-9-1990 and No.8/259/90-RR-2/8109 dated 11-7-1991:-

- i) These rules may be called **SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE TO WIDOWS OF RIOTS/TERRORISTS VIOLENCE (3rd) AMENDMENT RULES, 1992.**
- ii) The words "innocent civilians killed/100% physically disabled by the security forces acting in aid of civil power" may be substituted by the words "innocent civilians killed/100% permanently physically disabled by security forces in action or otherwise wherever they occur in these rules.
- iii) These Rules shall be applicable throughout the State of Punjab.

ELIGIBILITY

New clauses (xii), (xiii), (xiv), (xv) and xvi are added after the clause (xi) below the sub-rule (i) and (ii) of Rule 3 of Eligibility, namely :-

- xii) 100% physically disabled, Special Police Officers, rendered as such as result of terrorists attack, or by security forces during action against terrorists or otherwise.
- xiii) Widows of Home Guard Volunteers, who lost their bread-winners(husband) as result of terrorists activities/by security forces in action against terrorists or otherwise.
- xiv) Orphans, destitutes and 100% physically disabled Home Guards Volunteers, rendered as such, due to terrorists activities/by security forces in action against terrorists or otherwise.

- xv) The dependent parent(s) of Home Guards Volunteers killed in terrorists violence/ by security forces in action against terrorists or otherwise, if the deceased was married.
- xvi) Dependent parent(s) of the Home Guards Volunteers killed if he unmarried provided the son was the sole breadwinner for his parents).

Provided that the Subsistence Allowance will stop as and when the beneficiary or his/her nominee gets employed under priority category No.1.

RATE OF SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE

Subject to the provisions of Rules 7 and 10 or the aforesaid Subsistence Allowance Rules 1990, the subsistence allowance payable to each applicant shall be @ Rs.1000/- per month except the dependent parent(s) as mentioned in clause (vii) (x) and (xv) of Rule 3, where it shall be Rs.100/- (Rupees one hundred only) per month. The amount shall be remitted through Bank Draft to the claimants. Subsistence Allowance under the scheme to the persons falling under clause (xii), (xiii), (xiv), (xv) and (xvi) is payable for the life time with effect from 1-12-1991.

POWER TO SANCTION SUBSISTENCE ALLOWANCE

The Sub-Divisional Officer (c) concerned shall be the sanctioning authority under this scheme. He/She shall pass orders in each case on the basis of the certificate referred to in the column of verification vide Rule 3.

The expenditure involved is debitable to the Head "2235-Social Security & Welfare-60-Other Social Security and Welfare Programme-110-Other Insurance Scheme (09) Relief to persons affected by riots-02-Subsistence Allowance to victims of terrorist violence in Punjab."
